The mere absence of war is not peace, rather, peace requires far greater efforts such as the provision of fundamental human rights, opportunities for social inclusion and mobility. Moreover, a society can only be called cohesive when there is no discrimination and inequality and its citizens comply with their social contract and adhere to laws.

This was stated by speakers during the 15th round of the "Ulasi Taroon", a youth capacity building workshop organized by the Center for Research and Security Studies (CRSS) in collaboration with the Women University in Mardan.

Addressing the workshop, Swabi District Police Officer (DPO) Khalid Hamdani said that the basis of human survival was cooperation. This, he explained, was critical to Human Rights (UDHR).

"Being a student is a privilege and for youth's contribution for rule of law, the sky is the limit," he said, adding, "They [students] must develop critical thinking and challenge the stereotypes with a rational approach."




